OUR MISSION

The Revolution Softball Camps were developed to provide young athletes with the opportunity to become better softball players by providing instruction from the top coaches in a positive and fun atmosphere.

HEALTH & SAFETY

We want to ensure your child a safe and positive environment during their time at camp. Campers are expected to abide by the camp rules and live by our core values. Drugs, alcohol and tobacco products are strictly forbidden and constitute, along with general misconduct, grounds for dismissal from camp without a refund.

FINAL PAYMENT

Final Payments are due in our office by May 15th. Any camper with a remaining balance will be prohibited from checking into camp. We do not accept final payments at camp. Final payments can be paid via mail, over the phone, or through your online account. If you are unsure about your balance, please call us at 800.944.7112

CANCELLATION POLICY

Any Camper who must cancel their registration more than fifteen (15) days prior to the Camp start date will receive a voucher equal to the full amount of Camp tuition already paid which may be used toward any program or camp offered by eCamps. If a Camper must cancel their registration fourteen (14) days or fewer prior to the start of Camp, eCamps will issue Camper or Parent a voucher equal to 50% of the Camp tuition, which may be used toward any program or camp offered by eCamps. Vouchers are valid for any eCamps program within the same or next calendar year and are also transferable to another family member. Camp vouchers are not extended to Campers who leave Camp after the start of a session. The \$30 registration fee is non-refundable. *Cash refunds are not offered under any circumstances*.

CHECK-IN & CHECK OUT

Overnight: Check in will be from 11:30am-12:45pm on Monday July 21st at International Hall. Campers are required to return both keys. Parents will be charged for any lost/unreturned keys.

<u>Extended Day:</u> Check in will be from 12:30pm-1pm on Monday July 21st at the softball field. Campers should be dropped off at 9am (after the first day) and picked up at 7:00pm each day except the last day at 4pm at the field. Please have the camper dressed and ready to play.

<u>Day:</u> Check in will be from 12:30pm-1pm on Monday July 21st at the softball field. Campers should be dropped off at 9am and picked up at 4pm each day after the first at the field. Please have the camper dressed and ready to play.

Check Out: All Campers will check out at 4pm Thursday July 24th at the Softball Field.

HEALTH FORMS

Every camper must have the attached health history and release form filled out in order to attend camp. Please upload your health forms to your active.com account before the start of camp and bring in a copy with you to check in.

*A physician's signature is required on this form ONLY if you are attending a camp in CT, MA or NY. An attached physicians signed physical form from within two years will suffice but we ask you to attach it to our form below as there is a parents waiver and health insurance questions we need filled out. Camps in CT require the 'Administration of Medication' form for any medication brought to camp—this form can be found on SummerSoftballCamp.com.

CELL PHONE POLICY

Use of phones is not permitted during the instructional blocks of camp, including on-field and classroom sessions. We feel this will minimize distractions to the learning environment, help maintain an inclusive atmosphere and alleviate potential problems that can detract from the overall experience for everyone. Phone use will be allowed during in the mornings prior to morning session, at lunch, and for overnight camps before and after the evening session. We will still encourage players to minimize their time on devices in order to interact and engage with other campers, but understand they might want the chance to call home, text friends, etc.

CHECKLIST OF THINGS TO BRING

Below is a list of items to bring to camp. We suggest that campers do not bring expensive personal items such as cameras, iPods/iPads, etc. Please label every article you bring to camp. All items will be the responsibility of the camper. Revolution Softball and its camp staff are not responsible for lost, stolen or forgotten items.

- Glove, bat, helmet, cleats (NO METAL- all turf fields), catchers equipment (if necessary),
- Sneakers
- Slides or flip- flops
- T-shirts, tank tops, sweats, shorts, pajamas, sports bras, and athletic socks
- Bedding linens (extra long twin bed sheet for dorm sized mattress) & pillows
- Shower supplies- towel, shower shoes, and toiletries, toothbrush and paste
- Bathing Suit & Towel (pool optional)
- Sunscreen
- Portable Fan (Due for construction, there is NO AC in dorms for 2025)
- Snacks or drinks for in between sessions and meals (non perishable- NO Nuts)
- Required health forms
- Administration of medication form (if necessary)
- Individual Health Plan (if necessary)
